寮母 Dorm Mother	そうねえ。缶は別の袋に入れてください。資源ですから。 SÔNÊ. KAN WA BETSU NO FUKURO NI IRETE KUDASAI. SHIGEN DESU KARA.	Well. Please put cans into another bag. Because they are (recyclable) resources.
アンナ Anna	はい、分かりました。 HAI, WAKARIMASHITA.	Yes, I see.



#### Grammar Tips

#### ① TE-form verb + MO II DESU KA (May I \_?)

- ◆ If you say the TE-form verb with MO II DESU KA, it is an expression to ask for permission.

e.g.) KONO RINGO O TABETE MO II DESU KA. (May I eat this apple?)

↳ TE-form of TABEMASU (to eat)

#### ② \_ KARA (as/because \_) (1)

- ◆ KARA expresses the reason.

e.g.) SHIGEN DESU KARA, BETSU NO FUKURO NI IRETE KUDASAI.

(Because they are (recyclable) resources, please put them into another bag.)
