さくら Sakura	<small>わ</small> 分かった。そこにいて。 WAKATTA. SOKO NI ITE.	I see. Stay there.



Grammar Tips





① **MOSHIMOSHI** ("Hello" on the telephone)

② **TE-form verb + SHIMAIMASHITA** (Have done \_)

◆ You say SHIMAIMASHITA after the TE-form verbs to express that you have done something carelessly or absent-mindedly.

e.g.) MACHIGAEMASU (to make a mistake)

⇒ MACHIGAETE SHIMAIMASHITA (I've made a mistake)



Sound Words



OROORO



This word describes how a person has lost his/her presence of mind, or panicked.

UROURO



It describes how a person is moving around not knowing what to do.
