
さくら	ここは教室です。	Here's a classroom.

Sakura	SUGU SOKO DESU.	

**Grammar Tips****① _ WA DOKO DESU KA (Where is _ ?)**


- ❖ DOKO DESU KA is a phrase that allows you to ask where something is, either a place or thing.
e.g.) TOIRE WA DOKO DESU KA. (Where is a restroom?)

② KOSOADO words

- ❖ Japanese demonstratives are called KOSOADO words, taking the first syllables of the demonstratives of the four groups, such as KOKO (here), SOKO (there), ASOKO (over there), DOKO (where).
